Recharging Your Power Bank

Recharge the power bank via the USB-C ports.



If you have purchased Anker 100W Charging Base, you can also use it to recharge the power bank.



Connecting the Power Bank to the App

1. Download and open the Anker app.





2. Switch to the Bluetooth interface by pressing the button.



3. Press the button twice to enable Bluetooth.



4. Search for Bluetooth in the app and connect to it.

Trickle Charging Mode

1. Press the power button twice to activate trickle charging mode.



2. Connect your earbuds or other low-power devices to the USB-A port to start charging.



3. Press the power button twice to deactivate trickle charging mode.
