


APP



Download the soundcore app to experience adaptive noise cancellation, adjust ambient sound levels, update firmware, and access additional features.


If your headphones cannot connect to the soundcore app, re-install the app from your mobile app store or update it to the latest version.



Wear the headphones with the "L" marking on your left ear and the "R" marking on your right. Adjust the headband length for a comfortable fit.


CHARGING




Use the provided USB-C charging cable to connect your headphones to a power source. A full charge takes about 2 hours while 10 minutes of charging provides up to 10 hours of playtime.

- Ensure the headphones and USB-C charging port are fully dry before charging.
- Do not power on your headphones while charging.

POWERING ON & PAIRING






- 1. Press the power button for 2 seconds to power on the headphones.
- 2. Then, they will automatically enter Bluetooth pairing mode.
- 3. Select soundcore Q30* from your device's Bluetooth list to connect.
- * The product name varies by region.

Google Fast Pair: Enjoy instant pairing with your Android smartphone running Android 6.0 or higher.

To manually enter Bluetooth pairing mode, power off the headphones and press the power button for 5 seconds.


DUAL CONNECTIONS

To connect the headphones with two devices at the same time, first ensure they are connected to only one device. Then, press the power button twice to pair with the second device.




You can also enable Dual Connections through the soundcore app. In the soundcore app, go to Settings > Dual Connections > Enable Dual Connections > Connect New Device.

NOISE CANCELLATION




To reduce ambient noise, switch to Noise Cancellation mode using the NC button. Then, in the soundcore app, choose your preferred setting based on your environment.

TRANSPARENCY


To stay aware of your surroundings while listening to music, switch to Transparency mode using the NC button.



You can also activate Transparency mode by touching the right ear cup for 1 second.



To play audio from an external device, connect the provided 3.5 mm AUX cable. This will disable Bluetooth mode and the buttons will not work during wired listening.


POWERING OFF

• The headphones will automatically power off after 1 hour of inactivity. This duration can be customized in the soundcore app.


RESET



Reset your headphones if they malfunction or become unresponsive.


With the headphones powered on, press the volume up and power buttons simultaneously for 5 seconds until the LED slowly flashes red three times.
