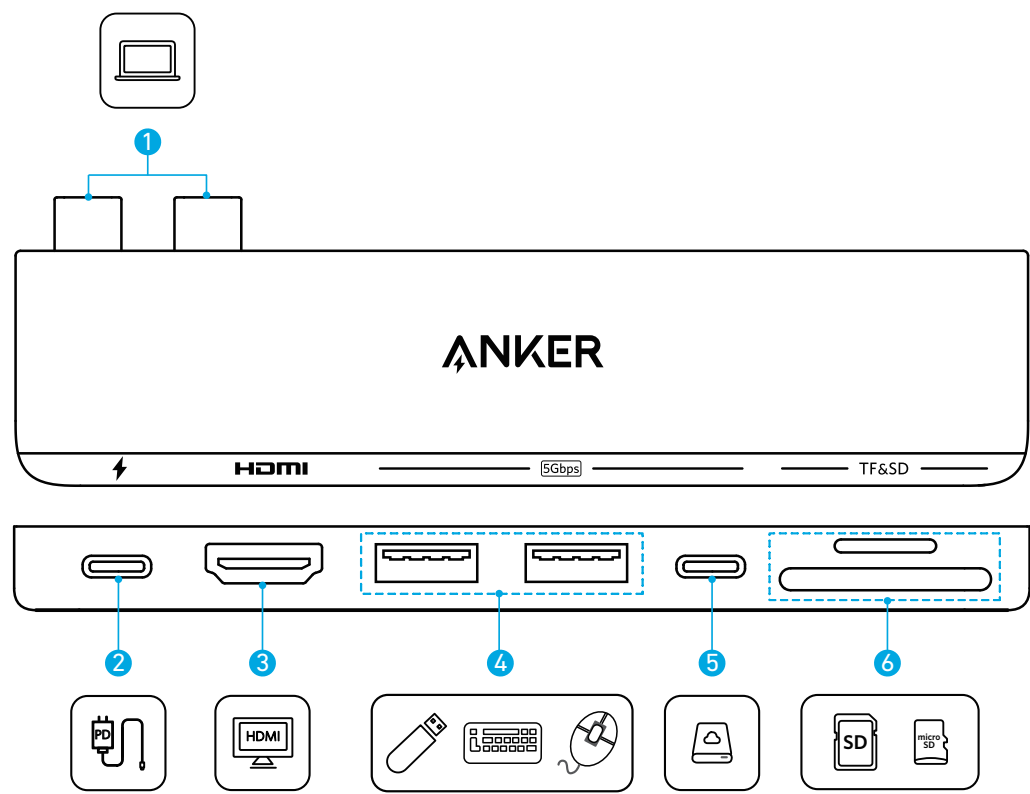


At a Glance



No.	Port Type	Description
1	USB-C connector	Plug into the MacBook's dual USB-C port
2	Multi-function port (USB-C port)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Connect to a USB-C charger to provide pass-through charging for your MacBook</li><li>• Connect to a USB-C device to transfer data at speeds up to 40 Gbps</li><li>• Connect to one monitor directly (two monitors via an HDMI adapter) to stream video at resolutions up to 5K@60 Hz</li></ul>
3	HDMI port	Connect to a device with an HDMI port to stream video at resolutions up to 4K@60 Hz
4	USB-A data port	Connect to a USB-A device to support data transfer at speeds up to 5 Gbps
5	USB-C data port	Connect to a USB-C device to support data transfer at speeds up to 5 Gbps
6	SD / microSD Card Slot	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• UHS-I, 104 MB/s</li><li>• The SD 3.0 card slot lets you insert an SD 3.0 card to copy files to and from your device.</li></ul>

Variable 'x'	Range of variable	Content
Seventh	0-9 or A-F	Denotes the hardware version which is not effected on the safety compliance.
Eighth	8,9,A,B,C...	Denotes the year, 8 means 2018, 9 means 2019, A means 2020, B means 2021, C means 2022, and so on.
Ninth and tenth	01,02,03...	Denotes weeks, 01 means the first week in this year, 02 means the secondary week in this year, and so on.
Eleventh	1-7	Denotes date, 1 means Monday, 2 means Tuesday..., 7 means Sunday and so on.
The last five	00001-99999	Denotes serial No.
